ADJECTIVE

A WORD THAT DESCRIBES A NOUN OR PRONOUN

TALL, GOOD, BEAUTIFUL, SOFT, KIND.

NOUN

A WORD THAT NAMES A PERSON, PLACE, ANIMAL, THING OR IDEA.

DOG, TEACHER, BOOK, DOLL, HAT.

VERB

A WORD THAT DESCRIBES AN ACTION OR STATE OF BEING.

SKIP, JUMP, THINK, AM, WAS.

ADVERB

A WORD THAT DESCRIBES A VERB. IT TELLS US HOW, WHEN, WHERE AND TO WHAT EXTENT.

SLOWLY, NOW, THEN, THERE, PARTIALLY.

ARTICLE

A WORD THAT IS USED BEFORE A NOUN TO DEFINE WHETHER IT IS SPECIFIC OR UNSPECIFIC.

A, AN, THE.

PRONOUN

A WORD THAT TAKES THE PLACE OF A NOUN AND CAN REPLACE A NAME.

HE, SHE, THEM, THEY, IT, HER, HIM.

INTERJECTION

A WORD OR SHORT PHRASE THAT SHOWS STRONG FEELINGS OR EMOTION.

YAY, SHUSH, OUCH, AHOY, BOO.

PREPOSITION

A WORD THAT TELLS YOU WHERE OR WHEN SOMETHING IS IN RELATION TO SOMETHING ELSE.

AT, BY, FROM, WITH, AFTER

CONJUNCTION

A WORD THAT CONNECTS TWO WORDS, PHRASES OR CLAUSES TOGETHER.

AND, ALSO, BUT, EITHER.
